I. We Are Set Apart People (Acts 13:2)

- A. "While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." - Acts 13:2
- B. "When you truly meet Jesus, He humbles you and you are changed forever." - G.P.
- C. This is the first missionary journey by the early church
- **D.** Everyone has a calling from the caller.

II. We Are Missional People (Acts 13:3)

- A. "So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off."
- B. "When Jesus transforms a person, He does so to grow the kingdom of God and bring salvation to more people who would trust in Him." – G.P.
- C. "Believers follow Jesus even into the unknown because Jesus works in marvelous ways, even if His disciples can't yet see His plan." – G.P.
- D. Saul's arrogance led him to be a persecutor of Christians but God converted the persecutor.

III. We Are Satisfied People (Acts 13:51-52)

- A. "So they shook the dust off their feet as a warning to them and went to Iconium. And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit."
- B. "If you know that God loves you, you should never question a directive from Him. It will always be right and best. When He gives you a directive, you are not just to observe it, discuss it, or debate it. You are to obey it." - Henry T. Blackaby
